## Rationale:

This lesson is important because students will learn the importance of wearing face masks to protect themselves during this time and be able to write a sentence about their design or upcoming holiday season.

- Getting creative with our face masks helps to visualize how a covid christmas can be fun
- Giving students the opportunity to share their designs during the walk around time

#### Kinesthetics:

- Movement from their desk to the carpet
- Art activity helps make learning fun
- Movement during the walk around time at the end of the lesson

## Differentiate Instruction (DI):

- Teacher will ensure that the students who may struggle are being supported in this lesson
- Recognizing that students who may struggle are being called upon first when they raise their hand
- Challenging students who are strong writers to participate in what is optional. To work towards writing two sentences about their face mask they designed or how they will have a covid safe christmas

## Lesson Activities:

Teacher Activities	Student Activities	Time
Introduction (anticipatory set - "HOOK"):		
Our Mask is our superhero cape  - Ask students to meet you at the carpet for story time  - Start with playing the video "Masked Heros" from 0:27 - 1:00  - Explain to students that we are going to be reading a story today that covers how to be safe during the holidays and protect ourselves from the coronavirus	<ul> <li>Students meet teacher at the carpet</li> <li>Students listen quietly and attentively to the instructions</li> <li>Students raise their hand to ask or answer questions</li> </ul>	3 Minutes
Body:		
<ul> <li>Read the story "A Coronavirus Christmas"         By Shannon Jett</li> <li>Pause and ask questions throughout the reading to ensure students are following along</li> <li>Explain the activity following the story</li> <li>Refer to your completed example of the handout to help students follow instructions</li> <li>Students will design their own face masks on the handout</li> <li>Students can be creative by drawing and colouring their design</li> <li>Students will write at least one sentence about how they will stay safe during christmas break</li> <li>Ask students to return to their desks quietly as you hand out the face mask templates</li> <li>Ask students to take out their pencils, erasers, and colours</li> <li>Play holiday music in the background while students are working independently</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Students listen to the story quietly and attentively</li> <li>Students raise their hand to ask questions along the way</li> <li>Students return to their desks and take out their supplies</li> <li>Students work independently on this activity</li> </ul>	24 Minutes
Closure:		
<ul> <li>Turn down the volume of the holiday music playlist</li> <li>Use "123 eyes on me 123 eyes on you" to get students attention</li> <li>Ask Students to put away their supplies and to leave their worksheet on top of their desk</li> <li>Ask students to walk around the classroom to take a look at their peers designs</li> <li>Ask students to give themselves a round of applause for a job well done:)</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Students draw their attention back to the teacher</li> <li>Students put away their supplies and leave their worksheet on top of their desk</li> <li>Students walk around to see all of the other designs created</li> <li>Students give themselves a round of applause for a job well done!</li> </ul>	3 Minutes

# Organizational Strategies:

- Face mask example is ready to show students
- Youtube link is ready to play
- Holiday playlist is ready to play
- Story book is next to the readers chair at the carpet
- Face mask templates will not be handed out until the instructions for the activity have been provided

## Proactive, Positive Classroom Learning Environment Strategies:

- Use "1 2 3 eyes on me, 1 2 3 eyes on you" to get the classrooms attention
- Pay close attention to students who may find this activity challenging and provide support where needed
- Read the story with enthusiasm and pause to answer or ask questions along the way to keep students engaged
- Verbally thank and address students who are following instructions to motivate students

## Extensions:

- If the lesson runs short ask students to write more than one sentence on their worksheet on what they will do this christmas to stay safe from covid.
- If the lesson runs too long students can take their handout home to complete, and bring it back the next day with it coloured and at least one sentence completed.
